What is Needed to Graduate High School?

19 COMPULSORY CREDITS

Students must earn the following 19 compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:

- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies
- 0.5 credit in civics and citizenship
- 1 credit in technology (grade 9 or 10)

GROUP 1, 2, and 3 COMPULSORY CREDITS

Of the 19 compulsory credits, students must complete one from each of the following groups:

Group 1:

- English (including the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course) or French as a second language
- Native languages
- First Nations, Metis, and Inuit studies
- classical studies and international languages
- social sciences and the humanities
- Canadian and world studies
- guidance and career education
- cooperative education

Group 2:

- health and physical education
- the arts
- business studies
- French as a second language
- cooperative education

Group 3:

- science (grade 11 or 12)
- technological education
- French as a second language
- computer studies
- cooperative education

IN ADDITION, STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE:

- 11 optional credits
- 40 hours of community involvement activities
- 2 eLearning credits
